- Provide four sections of Science instruction to students in grades 7, 8, and/or 9.
  - 7th grade: Sustainability Science
  - 8th grade: Introduction to Laboratory Science
  - 9th grade: Biology
- Drive students as required by other duties (this requires possession of a PSL).
- Report on the progress and development of each student.

## OTHER NON ACADEMIC DUTIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Serving as an advisor to a group of 6-8 students.
- Serving as an athletics coach in two (out of three) seasons or the equivalent thereof.
- Working as a part of the residential life community (exact duties to be determined by housing availability and school need).
