ABOUT MANARA SCHOOL:

ABOUT THE POSITION:

Manara School is seeking to hire faculty members in social studies for its 2024-2025 academic year. All faculty live on campus and contribute to the evening and weekend residential program as well as to the academic program.

The faculty member will teach ninth-grade history. This curriculum teaches students about ancient and Classical worlds from around the globe. The program places significant emphasis on ancient Egypt and devotes significant time to developing the skills necessary for critical and persuasive social science research.

The successful candidate will report to the Dean of Academics and will also work in close collaboration with the Dean of Students with regard to their residential duties.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach four course sections with responsibility for around 60 students (depending on the department and nature of the courses).
- Coach or direct three seasons of student sports and/or activities.
- Assist in special events as needed, such as community service events, trips, and outdoor excursions.
- Serve on relevant committees (such as discipline, accreditation, curriculum, etc.).
- Attend and contribute to all school programmatic events (e.g.

- Advise a group of students.
- Serve as a dorm parent and be a member of evening and weekend duty staffs on a rotational basis.
- Supervise study halls, as needed.
