POSITION SUMMARY

Saint James School is a historic Episcopal boarding school in Hagerstown, MD, serving 240 students in grade 8-12, and we seek a full-time Spanish teacher for the upcoming school year, starting August 2024. The teaching load is 4 or 5 classes, teaching Spanish I, II, or III. This position requires living in faculty housing in one of the dorms, assisting with dorm responsibilities including one night of duty, serving as an advisor to five to seven students, coaching or the equivalent for 1 or 2 seasons (depending on overall load), and being part of a weekend duty team.

At SJS we look for teachers who are growing in their professions and are life-long learners, eager to contribute meaningfully to our diverse school community. Our aim is to recruit and develop competent, motivated, and engaged educators with an international mindset. We are looking for colleagues who understand our vision, mission and philosophy, and are enthused by the prospect of helping our students grow in this context.

- A bachelor's degree in Spanish.
- Comfortable using technology in the classroom.
- Able to design structured lesson plans that include authentic sources.
- Some knowledge of Hispanic culture.
