In keeping with our school's mission, candidates should demonstrate an interest in "fostering enduring personal relationships" with boys and colleagues, and modeling the school's values of courage, compassion, and integrity. ## **QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS:**

- A bachelor's degree.
- Experience working with adolescents.
- Experience teaching math and/or working in a profession that requires math knowledge.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Teaches Upper School math classes.
- Leverages relational teaching practices and best practices for engaging boys.
- Makes content accessible and engaging to adolescents.
- Contributes to life of the middle school outside of the classroom (e.g. coaching or leading a club).
- Serves as a middle school advisor.
- Communicates clearly and directly with boys, parents, and colleagues.
- Challenges and supports all learners through differentiation and adherence to any recommendations provided by outside psychologists/providers.
- Supports community, equity, and inclusion programming.
- Chaperones occasional field trips, possibly including overnight and weekend trips.
- Pursues ongoing professional development.
- Proctors study halls.
- Enforces school rules and policies.
- Collaborates with lower and upper school faculty.
- Fulfills other duties as assigned by the Head of Middle School and Headmaster.

# **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Ability to maneuver or operate office type supplies and equipment including but not limited to files, paper, scissors, stapler, copier, phone, computer and filing cabinets.
- Ability to maintain emotional control while dealing with work-related stress.
- The individual may occasionally be required to bend or stoop.
- The individual may frequently be required to lift objects up to 20 pounds.
- Ability to sit for long periods of time.
- Must be able to communicate clearly in both spoken and written English.

## **WORKING CONDITIONS:**

- School environment, where there is not physical discomfort due to temperature, dust, noise or smoke.
- Exposure to stairs and non-handicap accessible areas.
- Exposure to work related stress in dealing with parents and students.
